สรุปเรื่อง

1. Tohoku University Science Summer Program 2016 (TSSP2016) สำหรับนักศึกษาในระดับปริญญาตรี สาขาวิทยาศาสตร์ และวิศวกรรมศาสตร์

2. Tohoku University Japanese Program 2016 (TUJP2016) การเรียนการสอนเกี่ยวกับวัฒนธรรมญี่ปุ่น

มหาวิทยาลัยสามารถเสนอชื่อนักศึกษาจำนวน ไม่เกิน 2 ราย สำหรับโปรแกรม TSSP2016 และไม่เกิน 3 ราย สำหรับโปรแกรม TUJP2016 กำหนดส่งใบสมัครภายในวันที่ 31 มีนาคม 2559 และ TU ได้กำหนดคุณสมบัติของนักศึกษาที่จะเข้าร่วมโครงการฯ ดังนี้

- มีเกรดเฉลี่ยไม่น้อยกว่า 2.3 จาก 3.0 (เทียบเท่า 3.0 จาก 4.00)
- มีผลสอบภาษาอังกฤษเทียบเท่า TOEFL iBT 70 หรือ PBT 520

และนักศึกษาที่ได้รับคัดเลือกอาจจะได้รับทุน JASSO จำนวน 80,000 เยน รายละเอียดดังแนบ

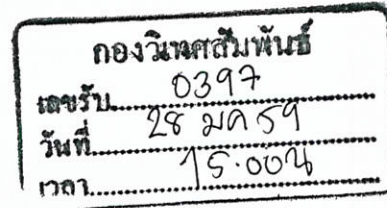

Japan Student Services Organization (JASSO)
Student Exchange Support Program
Scholarship for Short-term Study in Japan
[as of January 2016]

This scholarship is available for qualified international students who are accepted by Japanese universities under student exchange agreements on a short-term basis. JASSO selects exchange programs carried out by Japanese universities every year and allocates a scholarship quota to each university. Tohoku University will be able to nominate qualified students to JASSO within that quota.

1. Eligibility

- (1) Students demonstrating excellent academic and personal records at their home university.
- (2) Students having a definite motivation as well as a clear study plan in any field available at their host universities and likely to benefit from studying in Japan.
- (3) Students not having sufficient financial means to study in Japan.
- (4) Students who, upon termination of the period of study in Japan, will resume or complete their studies at their home university.
- (5) Students who will not receive any kind of scholarship that exceeds JPY 80,000 per month specifically for Tohoku University's exchange programs.
- (6) Students who do not currently possess Japanese citizenship.
- (7) Students who have a minimum GPA of 2.30 / 3.00 as calculated using JASSO's GPA calculation method shown below, based on a transcript from the previous academic year.

Calculating GPA:

- You must demonstrate excellent academic achievements at your home university, as well as a good personality; in addition, you must have minimum GPA of 2.30, as calculated using JASSO's GPA calculation method, based on a transcript from the previous academic year. If your transcript from the previous academic year is not available, your GPA will be calculated based on a transcript from the previous semester. In case converting grades using JASSO's calculation method is impossible, we will measure your academic excellence from your transcript and other materials.
- Meeting JASSO's criteria alone does not guarantee acceptance to the scholarship program. All applicants go through a Tohoku University's screening process.
- Use the table below to convert grades into grade points. Then use the grade points and the formula below to calculate the GPA.
- When calculating GPA, round off to two decimal places. For example, 2.654 would be rounded to 2.65, while 2.655 would be rounded to 2.66.

*If you have taken courses that are not part of the credit system, replace the number of credits in the GPA formula with the number of courses taken.

2. Scholarship Conditions

Stipend: JPY 80,000

3. Application Method

Submit the "Application Form for JASSO Scholarship" with application materials for the student exchange program no later than the application deadline. Students must be nominated by their home institution first and direct applications from students to Tohoku University or to JASSO will not be accepted. Students cannot apply after the application period, including days after they come to Japan.

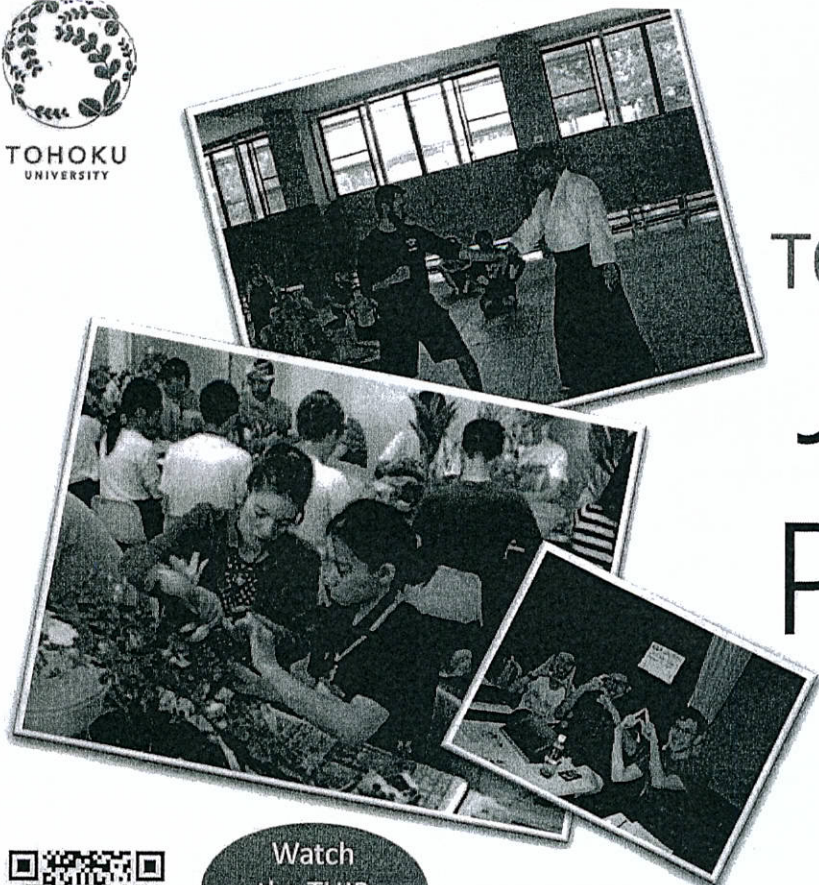

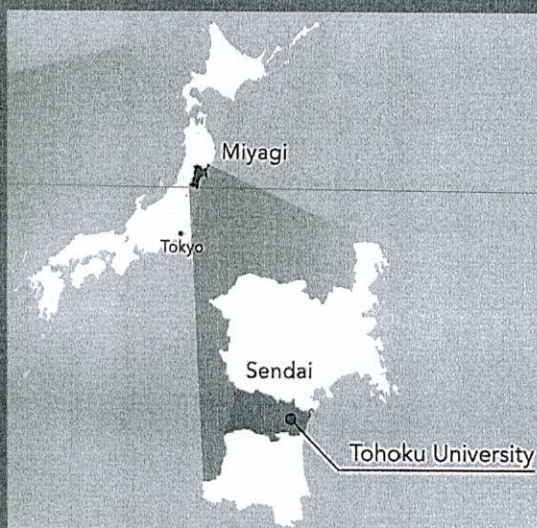

Sendai is characterized by a very moderate climate, yet you can experience the beauty of the four seasons. Usually, only a few days in summer are hotter than 30 C (86 F), and few days in winter are colder than -3 C (26 F).

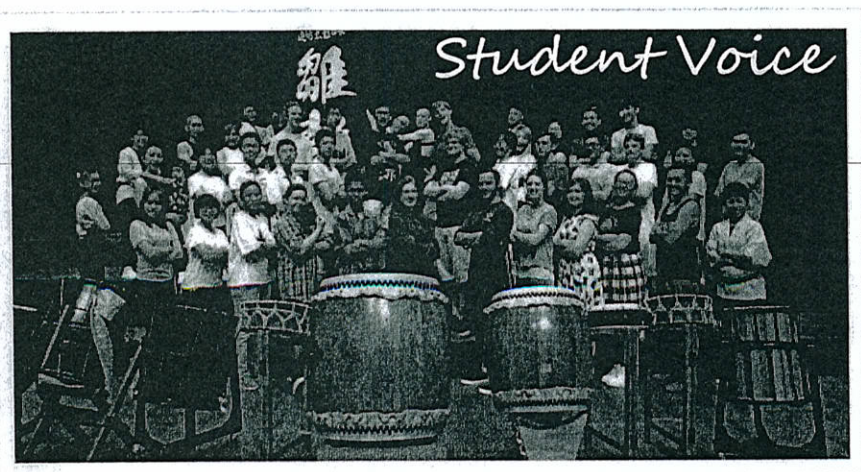

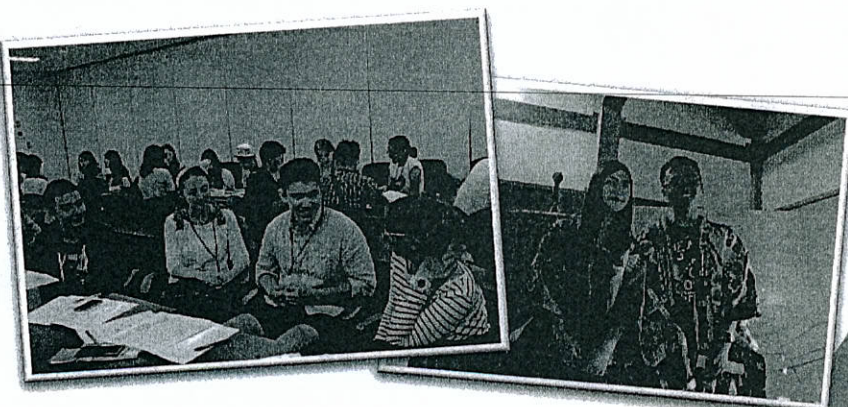

ACCOMMODATION

The university-contracted off-campus accommodations (hotel) will be a 20-min. walk from Kawauchi Campus, where most classes and activities will be held during the program. Each student will be assigned a furnished bedroom with a unit bathroom. Breakfast is not included but available upon request (¥800/meal). Participants will need to pay accommodation fees at the end of the program directly to the hotel (¥74,800 in total).

MEDICAL INSURANCE

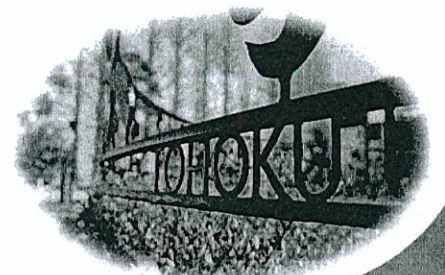

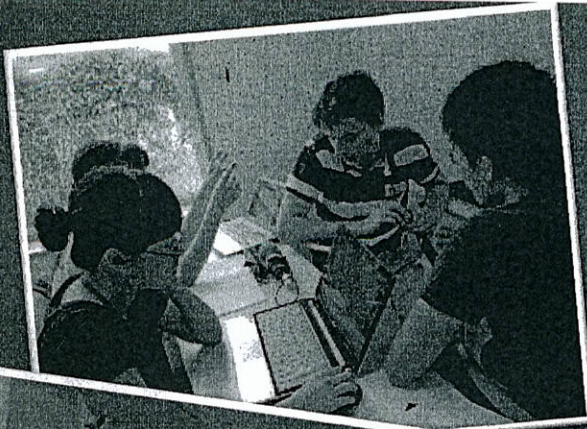
VISAS

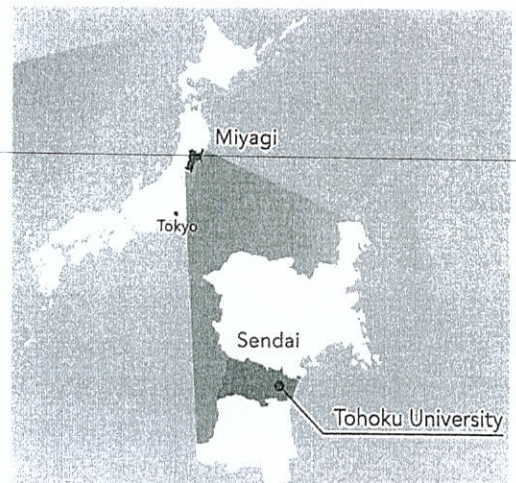

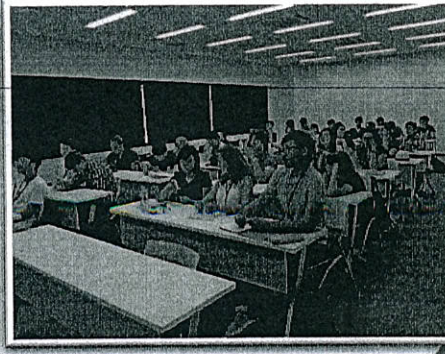
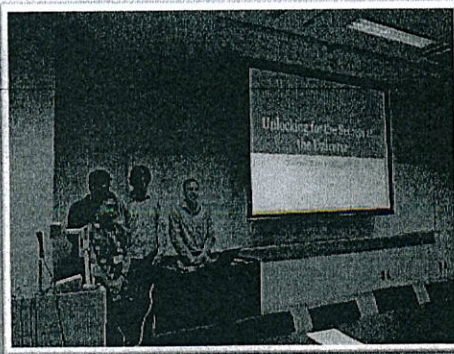

ACCOMMODATION

Each student will stay in a furnished bedroom with a unit bathroom at a hotel located in a convenient area. Breakfast is not included but is available upon request (¥800/meal). Participants will need to pay accommodation fees at the end of the program directly to the hotel (¥61,100 total).

MEDICAL INSURANCE

Summer program participants are required to buy travel insurance in their own country BEFORE coming to Japan. Students will be solely responsible for any accidents that occur while staying in Japan. Their insurance must cover death and medical care expenses not only due to accidental bodily injury but also for sickness.

VISAS

Those who need a visa to enter Japan should indicate this on their application forms. Tohoku University will provide an invitation letter to admitted students. Passport holders of certain countries do not need a visa to enter Japan for periods of less than 90 days.
