Details for Spring 2017 Session

Sanuki Program is administered by the Kagawa University International Office (hereafter, KUIO). It is a one semester program that is conducted twice in an academic year, and is targeted towards exchange students with no or little prior knowledge of the Japanese Language.

Scholarship

For Spring Semester 2017, we are fortunate to have secured several JASSO scholarships for exchange students. The monthly stipend is JPY 80,000 per scholarship. This will enable students to cover the daily living expenses, as well as the medical, accident, and health insurances. The scholarship period is from March 2017 to July 2017 (five months).

We would like your office/institution to recommend up to three students to apply for this scholarship. However, please note that there is no guarantee that we can accept all students recommended.

Criteria for selection

- 1. Grade Point Average (See file attached file 'Note on GPA')
- 2. Study plan (Applicants are required to express their reason for applying to join the Sanuki Program. Applicants who exhibit a clear academic interest in some aspect of Kagawa Prefecture shall be preferred. Applicants are advised to search 'Kagawa Prefecture' in the internet to obtain more information on the subject.)
- 3. Recommendation letter from academic supervisor or professor

Language requirement

Japanese language ability is not required. Classes in Sanuki Program are intended for elementary level students.

Tuition fees

These shall be waived in accordance to the Memorandum of Understanding, where applicable. Otherwise, tuition fees shall be charged accordingly.

Accommodation

All successful candidates shall be housed at the Kagawa University Kaminocho International Dormitory. Apartments are twin-sharing. The rental for each resident is about JPY 20,000 per month, excluding utilities.

Travel

All successful candidates are required to arrive at Takamatsu Station on 23th March 2017, Thursday, within office hours (09:00-17:00). Our staff shall meet and greet all students at the station. Successful candidates shall bear all travel expenses, which include the air ticket to and from Japan, and the land transport to and from Takamatsu Station. Application method

All application processes (correspondences, submission of documents, etc.) must go through the International Coordinator of the applicant's university.

Students may not directly correspond or send the application documents by themselves.

The application process is as follows:

First, submit by airmail or EMS the original copy of 'Certificate of current enrollment' (not 'Certificate of Acceptance into University').

Next,

- 1. Submission of electronic version of all other documents through email.
- 2. Our staff shall check the electronic documents for accuracy.
- 3. If there are errors or incomplete items, applicants need to rectify them.

November 2016: Invitation for applications

5th December 2016: Deadline for submission of application materials

Mid-January 2017: Selection and announcement of successful candidates

23rd March 2017 (Thu): Arrival of successful candidates at Takamatsu Station
