Eligibility	 ✓ Be currently enrolled as a full-time undergraduate or graduate student at an NCHU partner institution. ✓ Have successfully completed at least one year of study at home institution. ✓ Be nominated by the Office of International Affairs or equivalent office of the home institution according to exchange agreements. 			
Benefits	 Tuition waiver (The fees of mandatory insurance and accommodation are not included. Students need to pay both fees by themselves.) Monthly stipend will be offered upon budget availability and qualification of students. We will offer Free Basic Chinese Course. (Non-Credit; More information will be provided after students are admitted.) [Note] Benefits only apply to the nominees that fall within the agreed quota of the partner university agreement.
