Graduate Studies	The International Exchange and Educational Program for Food Safety is an international student exchange program developed by the Food Science Group of Faculty of Agriculture of Kagawa University. This program provides the opportunity for young future researchers to network internationally while gaining international experience. Students are expected to exchange information, share experiences, and their research with each other. The primary language for this program exchange will be English.
Scholarships	This program will be held at the Faculty of Agriculture from <u>August 18 to September 20, 2014</u> . We will invite 20 international students to participate in the program.
Our Dean	This program is partially funded by a grant from the Japan Student Services Organization (JASSO), a governmental support agency for scholarship loan programs, support programs for international students, and student support programs founded by the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology (MEXT), and Kagawa University.
Faculty Members	Each attending students who attend will receive a stipend (in cash) shortly after their arrival to help defray their travel, lodging and other costs.
